Subject: Closure of COVID outbreak

Hi To All Family Members and NOK's

This email is to inform you that the current COVID outbreak at Edgarley Assisted Living has been closed. We have had no further residents test positive as of today 26/04/2023. The facility currently has one staff member positive. This staff member is away from work for the seven-day period. The Public Health Unit and DOH have been informed of the new case.

Visitation of Family Members, NOK and friends are to continue as per post outbreak except visitors are to continue to wear NP95 until Friday the 28th. Please continue with antiseptic hand rub before entering the facility and on leaving.

All visitors are still required to have a negative RAT test before visiting any area of Edgarley Assisted Living (including weekends). All visitors please present to the front office at new building.

Also, if possible, can you please pass onto any friends that may wish to visit, this information. We will continue to update you, if we have any further COVID positive resident cases or changes in direction.

Edgarley continues to remain vigilant of monitoring any resident for COVID symptoms and immediately isolates symptomatic residents. RAT testing of residents after Friday will only be attended if residents are showing symptoms. Please, if you have any question or concerns relating to this email, contact me at the facility.
