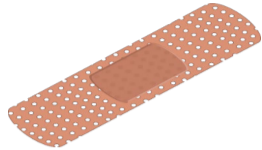


February INFORMATIVE REPORT

- 3 Grazes



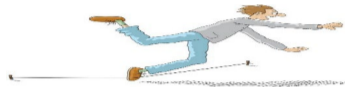
146 MAINTENANCE REQUESTS
