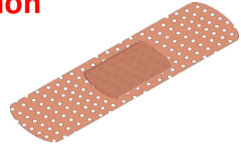


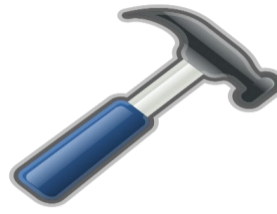

- 1 Excoriation



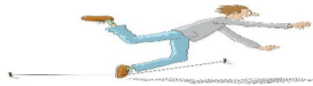
140 MAINTENANCE REQUESTS
