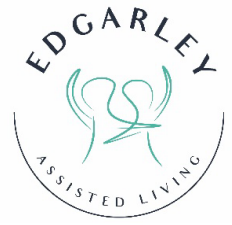

To: Residents, NOK, POA & Families

Edgarley is writing to update you on our current **Respiratory Syncytial Virus (RSV)** outbreak.

Edgarley received conformation this morning from the PHU, informing us that as we have had no further residents test positive for RSV. They can confirm that the respiratory outbreak at Edgarley Assisted Living Casterton can be stood down. All of our residents are now out of isolation. As we currently have staff positive for RSV and isolating at home, we will continue to have staff wear NP95 masks. Visitors will not be required to wear a mask within the facility. We would still ask anyone that has cold or flu symptoms to refrain from visiting.

We would like to thank all residents, NOK and families for their continued support and understand over the last few weeks.

We would also like to thank the staff, including the agency staff that have worked during the outbreak. They have been instrumental in containing the outbreak to one wing & for that we are extremely thankful.
